We had 12 teams signed up but 3 had to pull out on Monday before the competition. It was their Spring Break and they were not sure they could attend the competition and still make the bus trip scheduled. The remaining 9 teams entered a total of 18 "A" teams and 9 "B" teams. One of the teams was a NJROTC school. This was a total of 162 competitors (54 were "B" teams).
